BLDE Association – An overview

The BLDE Association is a premier educational organisation in north Karnataka, founded in 1910 with the purpose of spreading education on the model of Deccan Education society of Poona in Bombay Province. Today it has grown into a Banyan tree sheltering under its spreading shady branches several institutions in various fields. In fact it is a mini University dreaming of Deemed University status. It is running more than 46 different institutions in Bijapur city comprising of about 25 schools and colleges in a land area of about 100 acres.

It began in a small way by running a High School handed over to it by German mission which was leaving the country on the outbreak of First World War. The Association opened its first collegiate institution in 1946 under the Bombay University. When it moved over to its new campus of 54 acre land area, the Bangaramma Sajjan campus, SB Arts and KCP Science College, New Arts College..... the last goes on and on. Engineering, Medical and Education colleges were later on added to this list which became colourful feathers in the cap of BLDE Association. The Association did not confine its functioning to Bijapur city alone. It felt the need of spreading education in the other to the needs of rural and urban masses.

Late. Dr. P.G. Halakatti popularly known as “ Vachana Pitamaha” was responsible for the establishment of BLDE Association in 1910 with the support of philanthropists and local leaders. His Holiness Sri. Banthanala Sangana Basava Seemiji blessed and graced by steering forth for the growth of organisation in the second phase.
