BLDE Association is one of the pioneering Educational Association in the North Karnataka. It has a large network of several institutions like Degree colleges, PU colleges and Medical and Engineering Colleges. It has also institute of Business management, Physical Education and Ayurveda College.

Under the guidance of the far sighted Visionary and General Secretary late Shri B.M Patil, BLDE Association's J.S.S College of Education was started in the year 1980. It was previously affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad. Now it is affiliated to Rani Channama University Belagavi. Dr Jagadeesh B. took the charges of the institution as Principal in 2007. Presently it runs the B.Ed and M.Ed programmes.

The special feature of the institution is it has a highly qualified faculty all most 90% of the members of staff have Ph.D degree in Education. The Research activities are undertaken by members of faculty. Five members of faculty are involved in the institutional projects and Post Doctoral research programmes. The institution has launched its own research Journal entitled, "Journal of BLDE Association Education and Research" with ISSN 2258-3188, enabling faculty and students to publish their creative work. The institution also conducts State and National level Seminars and Workshops involving students and faculty in various subjects. Students are initiated in various innovative learning techniques like Concept Attainment model, Brain storming, Buzz, Panel discussion, Group discussion etc. Most of the members of faculty are engaged in framing the syllabus and examination work in KU Dharwad and RC University Belagavi.

The institution has made a special provision of learning for average and brilliant students. Remedial classes are being conducted to help students in their studies. Student feedback mechanism serves as a guideline for the improvement of faculty. In pursuance of self study students are encouraged to utilize library facilities to enhance their knowledge and develop the habit of independent studies. Physically Challenged students get special attention in this regard. The Mentoring system has enabled the members of faculty to identify and address the students difficulties. In addition to RC University examination pattern the college conducts regular Seminars and gives assignments to students throughout the year. Students are appraised of their performance from time to time.

A Brief Account of Infrastructure:

The college has a spacious building which provides adequate accommodation for class rooms, lecture halls, laboratories, library and administrative blocks.

Library:

Over the years the college has developed a rich library with more than 16200 volumes. The collection comprises of books on core papers, method papers and optional papers both in Kannada and English. The collection includes text books, reference books, encyclopedias and dictionaries, educational and research survey books etc, related to both B.Ed and M.Ed courses. Online accessibility of E-journals provision is made for students.

Laboratories:

The college has separate Science laboratory, Psychology laboratory, Language laboratory, Educational technology and Computer laboratory.

Laboratory of Educational Technology:

The college has laboratory of educational technology which is equipped with the technological gadgets like Smart board, Slide projectors, etc. This facility is being used by staff and students.

Science laboratory:

Science laboratory is well equipped with all the necessary apparatus.

Psychology laboratory:

The psychology laboratory is equipped with all the necessary equipments for the conduct of psychological experiments.

Computer laboratory:

There is well equipped computer laboratory with 18 computers. All the necessary accessories, internet facilities and softwares required for the conduct of practical classes are available.

The College has maintained a consistent bright record of students in examinations both in B.Ed and M.Ed.
