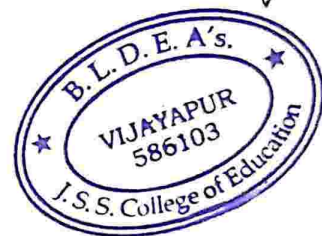
There is a well behind Sath Kabar. It is the place where Afzal Khan killed his wives by drowning them.

# Brainstorming :

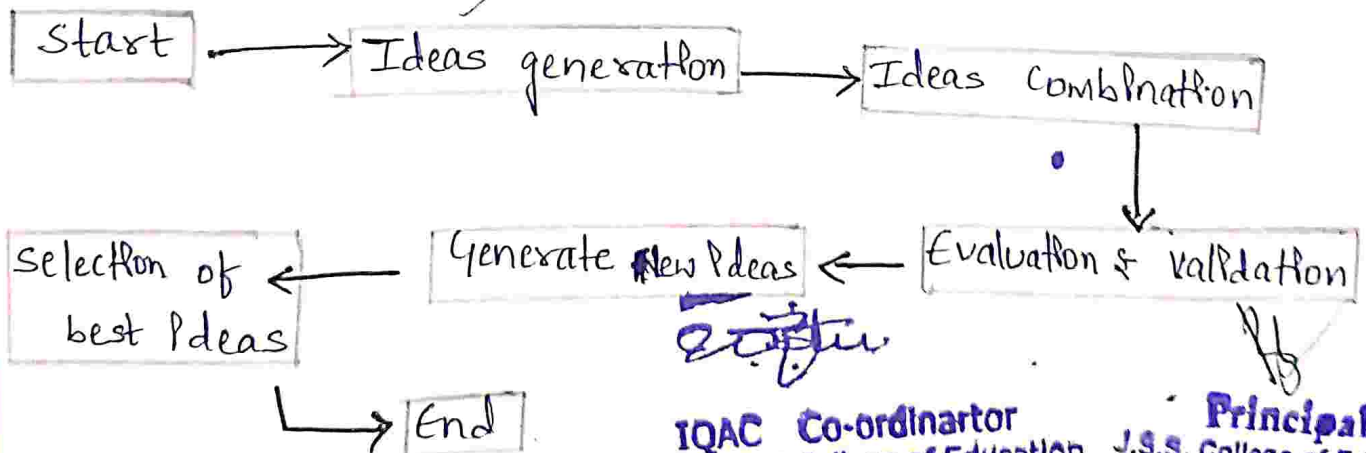

## Types of brainstorming :

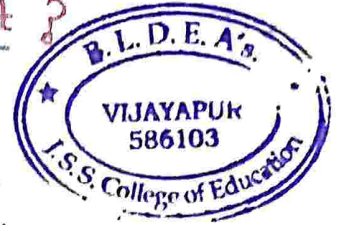

**Characteristics of Unit Plan**

- **Objective Based**-The objectives of unit should be clearly defined and the plan of unit should be based on these objectives. Objectives should be in written form.
- **Relevant teaching aids**-A unit plan should include how long aids have and when to be used. Teaching of unit should be supported by a set of appropriate teaching aids like charts, graphs, pictures, diagrams, maps etc.
- **Use of simple language**-An ideal unit plan should emphasize on the simplicity and clarity of the subject and the mental capacity of the students.
- **Use of strategies, tactics, techniques and teaching aids**-A teacher should have good command over general principles of teaching, so that he can use the strategies and the techniques accordingly in the classroom.
- **Illustration**-An ideal unit plan should incorporate illustrative and concrete material to the daily life of the students.

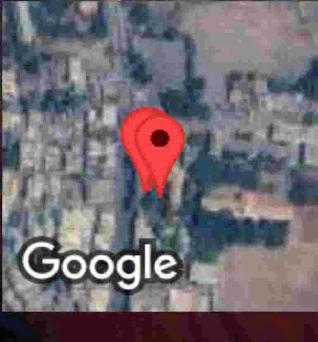
