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Interior and Exterior of Triangle

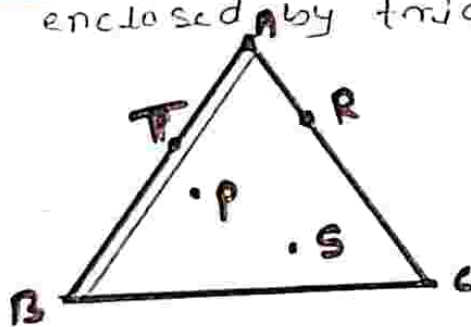
In triangle ABC there are 3 points.

Interior region \rightarrow The points lie inside the region enclosed by triangle.

on the sides \rightarrow The points lie on the side of triangle

Exterior region \rightarrow The points lie outside the region enclosed by triangle.

Ex \rightarrow



Triangular region \rightarrow The interior of Δ ABC together with the Δ ABC itself is called the triangular region ABC.

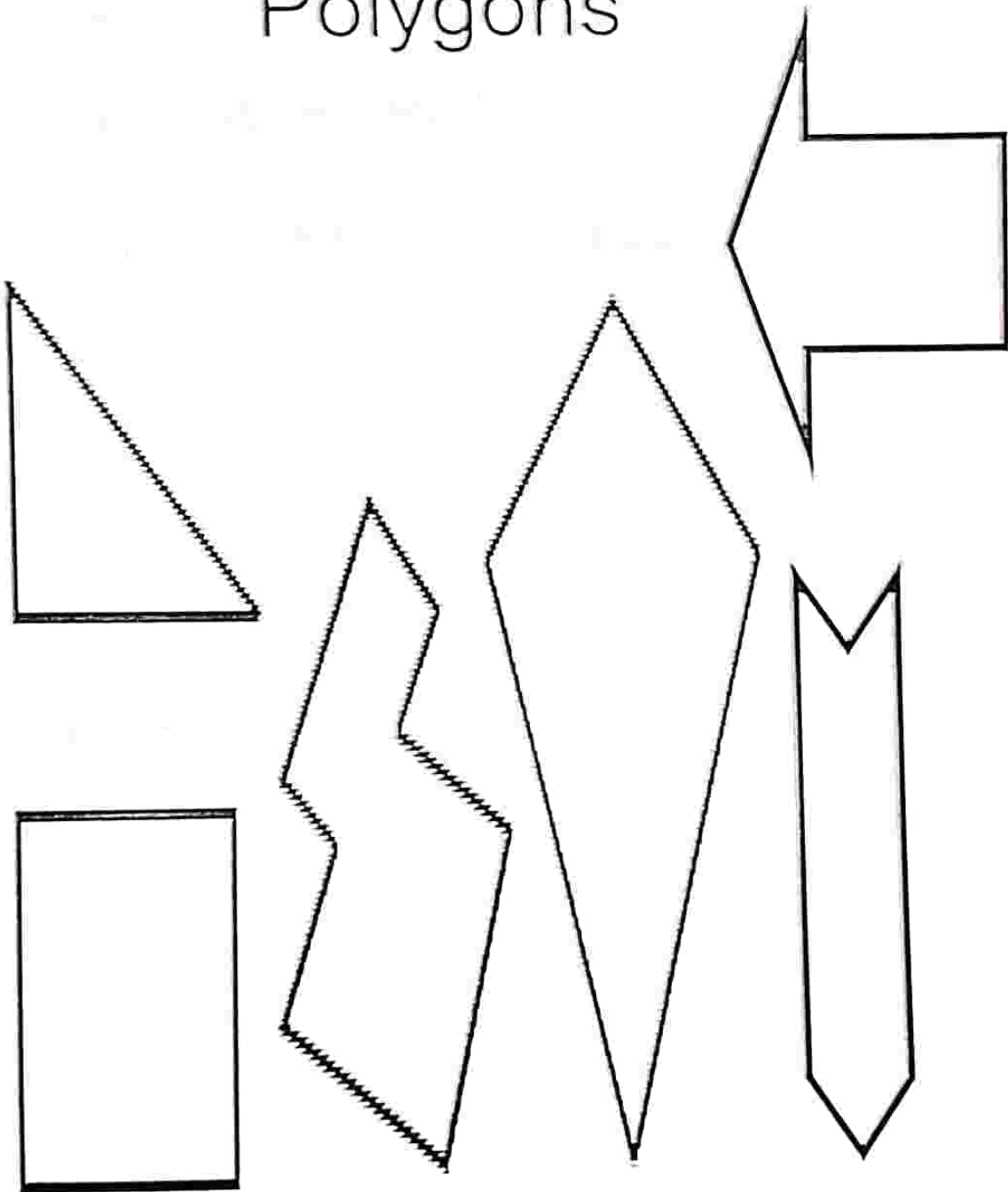

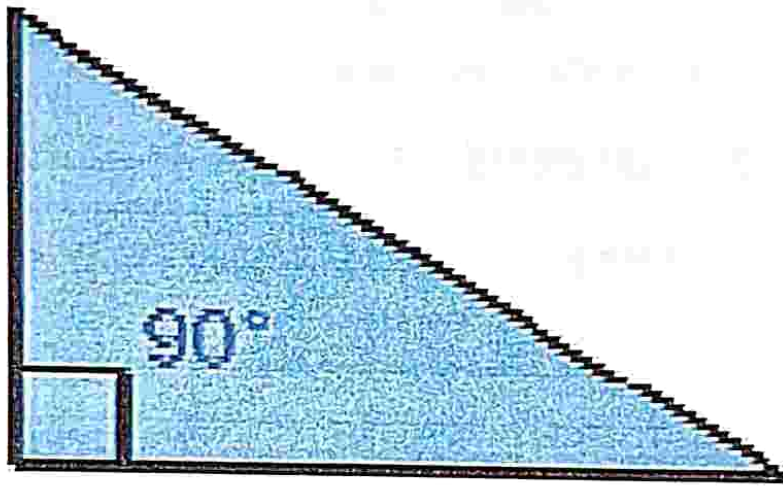

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Basics of Statistics

Definition: Science of collection, presentation, analysis, and reasonable interpretation of data.

Statistics presents a rigorous scientific method for gaining insight into data. For example, suppose we measure the weight of 100 patients in a study. With so many measurements, simply looking at the data fails to provide an informative account. However statistics can give an instant overall picture of data based on graphical presentation or numerical summarization irrespective to the number of data points. Besides data summarization, another important task of statistics is to make inference and predict relations of variables.

ON GROUPS AND SUBGROUPS

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Groups and Subgroups

Definition

A *group* is a nonempty set G on which there is defined a binary operation $(a, b) \rightarrow ab$ satisfying the following properties.

Closure: If a and b belong to G , then ab is also in G ;

Associativity: $a(bc) = (ab)c$ for all $a, b, c \in G$;

Identity: There is an element $1 \in G$ such that $a1 = 1a = a$ for all a in G ;

Inverse: If a is in G , then there is an element a^{-1} in G such that $aa^{-1} = a^{-1}a = 1$.

A group G is *abelian* if the binary operation is commutative, i.e., $ab = ba$ for all a, b in G . In this case the binary operation is often written additively $((a, b) \rightarrow a + b)$, with the identity written as 0 rather than 1

Definitions A *subgroup* H of a group G is a nonempty subset of G that forms a group under the binary operation of G . Equivalently, H is a nonempty subset of G such that if a and b belong to H , so does ab^{-1} . (Note that $1 = aa^{-1} \in H$; also, $ab = a((b^{-1})^{-1}) \in H$.)

Introduction

What is a group?

Definition 1.1: If G is a nonempty set, a *binary operation* μ on G is a function $\mu : G \times G \rightarrow G$. For example $+$ is a binary operation defined on the integers Z . Instead of writing $+(3, 5) = 8$ we instead write $3 + 5 = 8$. Indeed the binary operation μ is usually thought of as

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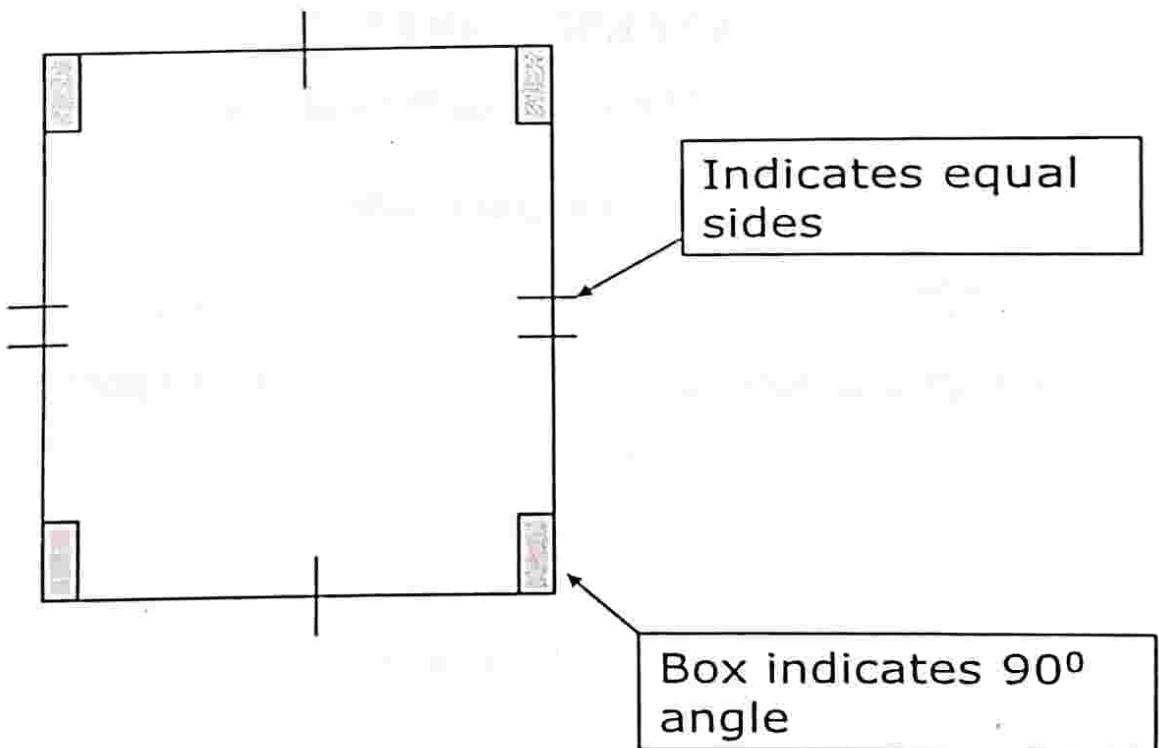
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Types of Quadrilaterals
