- o Comments: A substantial recovery from the previous year, with strong placement numbers indicating a rebound in the job market.

• Academic Year 2022-23

- o Total Students Placed: 65
- o Placement Types: Government-aided and unaided high schools, and other roles including P.S.I, FDA, SDA, PDO.
- o Comments: The highest number of placements in this period, showing the institution's effective placement strategies and a favorable job market.

· Academic Year 2023-24

- o Total Students Placed: 62
- o Placement Types: Government-aided and unaided high schools, and positions such as P.S.I, FDA, SDA, PDO.
- o Comments: Consistent performance with only a slight decrease from the peak year, reflecting stability in the college's placement outcomes.

Placement Distribution by Job Type

- Government-Aided and Unaided High Schools: The majority of placements each year have been in government-aided and unaided high schools, indicating a strong alignment with the college's primary training focus.
- Other Jobs (P.S.I, FDA, SDA, PDO): A significant number of students have secured roles in various government positions such as Police Sub-Inspectors, First Division Assistants, Second Division Assistants, and Panchayat Development Officers, showcasing the versatility of the college's placement support.
